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**MINUTES OF THE 17<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF TRIPURA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY CONDUCTED THROUGH CIRCULATION AND COMPLETED ON 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2020.**

The 17<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors of the Institute was held on November 6, 2020 at 2.00 P.M. in online mode using Google Meet platform.

Smt. Saumya Gupta, IAS, Chairperson of the Board of Governors (BOG), TIT, Agartala, and Secretary of Higher Education, Government of Tripura presided over the meeting. Prof. H. K. Sharma, Co-Chairperson of the Board of Governors (BOG), TIT and Director, NIT Agartala has also graced the meeting. The following members of the BOG have attended in the meeting:

The following decisions are taken by the BOG Members as mentioned below item wise.

**Item No.17.1 Confirmation of the minutes of 16<sup>th</sup> BOG meeting.**

The minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> BOG meeting as circulated to all concerned were placed for confirmation and accepted by the Board.

**Item No.17.2 Present status of ongoing TEQIP-III Project as on 30-09-2020.**

The House has noted about the present status of TEQIP-III.

**Item No.17.3 Revision in percentage allocation for procurement out of Project Life Allocation (PLA) of TIT.**

National Project Implementation Unit (NPIU) has increased the allocation for procurement from 60% (existing) to 70% (revised) without changing the total Project Life Allocation (PLA) of TIT and directed to incur the fund within December'2020 to enhance the infrastructures for online teaching related activities. NPIU has also directed in its recent notification to follow either GeM or NIC e-procurement portal (like State Govt. e-procurement portal under NIC) for procuring the items under TEQIP-III Project.

In this context, the House has agreed to the proposal to allocate maximum Rs.70 lacs from Academic-Head to Procurement-Head to enhance infrastructures for online teaching-learning activities.

**Item No.17.4 Proposal for new packages under revised percentage allocation in procurement-head.**

The House has agreed to the revised percentage allocation in Procurement-head to strengthen digital learning processes as proposed. The following packages are considered for procurement using enhanced allotment for procurement under TEQIP-III fund with few directions:

**Item No.17.5 Re-engagement of 03(three) nos. of staff under TEQIP-III.**

House approved for re-engagement of the following 03(three) nos. of staff under TEQIP-III Project after expiry of the present engagement on 22nd January, 2021 till the revised project completion period of TEQIP-III Project i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 at the existing monthly salary and same terms and conditions:

**Item No.17.6 Ratification of some decisions, approval and sanction of funds by the Principal for implementation of TEQIP-III Project as per delegation of power.**

The Institute Authority has confirmed that all the expenditure and activities are made as per the prevailing norms of World Bank Project, TEQIP-III. Hence, the expenditure made for implementation of TEQIP-III Project w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020 to 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2020, for items under 07(seven) nos. of heads of academic activities with expenditure amounting to Rs.19,24,511.00 and items under 05(five) nos. of heads of IOC activities with expenditure amounting to Rs.15,37,428.00 have been ratified by the House in view of compliance of TEQIP rules.

**Item No.17.7 Hiring of MIS Executive on Contract basis.**

The House has agreed to the proposal of hiring one dedicated MIS Executive on contract basis for a tenure of six months to complete various data entry related work and maintain liaison with the vendor in solving various implementation issues as and when required and to make the system fully operational utilizing institutional fund accumulated from Tuition fees. The House has advised to take up this issue further with the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Tripura for administrative approval and upper limit of salary.

**Item No.17.8 Maintenance of existing garden in the new Degree campus of Tripura Institute of Technology.**

The House has agreed to the proposal of regular maintenance of existing garden in the new Degree campus of Tripura Institute of Technology by utilizing institutional fund accumulated from Tuition fee through the 'Department of Horticulture and Soil Conservation', Govt. of Tripura.

**Item No.17.9 Major maintenance work of the new Degree campus of Tripura Institute of Technology.**

The House has agreed to the proposal of need based estate related major maintenance work, like Civil works, Electrical works, IRP works, Water supply related works, Sewage works (STP) etc. in the new Degree campus of Tripura Institute of Technology to carry out through suitable Government Organizations/Departments, like PWD/RD/Tripura Housing Board, TSECL, DWS, Agartala Municipal Corporation etc. These maintenance works would be carried out as per the Government rates as fixed up by the concerned departments and the expenditure for these said works may be met up from the institutional fund accumulated from Tuition fee.

**Item No.17.10 Maintenance of building, classrooms and cleaning of entire Old Campus of TIT.**

In order to ensure academic activities related to Diploma Engineering Program of Tripura Institute of Technology, the House has agreed to allow bare minimum maintenance and cleaning of the old campus for the time being just to continue classes by utilizing institutional fund received from tuition fees.

**Item No.17.11 Development of Research Laboratory for New M.Tech. Programs.**

The House has agreed to the proposal to set up Research Laboratories in the respective departments for the 03(three) upcoming M.Tech. Programs i.e. Data Science, VLSI & Embedded Systems and Thermal Engineering for providing research facility. Accordingly, following fund allocation as proposed in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase to facilitate the same, utilizing fund accumulated from Degree tuition fees is permitted.

**Item No.17.12 Faculty recruited under TEQIP-III Project.**

The House has agreed upon the necessity of retention of the contractual faculty members, recruited under TEQIP-III Project, after the closure of the Project i.e. on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2021 to maintain the smooth Teaching-Learning Process and also to maintain student faculty ratio as per AICTE & NBA requirements. As the institutional fund is not sufficient to meet up the expenditure related to retention of such faculty, the House recommends it to be taken up by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Tripura for consideration.
