MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 7TH DECEMBER, 2024 AT 1130 HRS IN SECRETARIAT CONFERENCE HALL NO. II UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE CHIEF SECRETARY IN CONNECTION WITH THE OBSERVANCE OF STATEHOOD DAY AND REPUBLIC DAY PROGRAMME-2025.

List of participants at Annexure- A.

With kind consent of the Chief Secretary, the Secretary, GA(Political) Department welcomed all the participants and briefly explained the significance for observance of Statehood Day/Republic Day. After discussion the following decisions were taken for observance of Statehood Day programme on 21st January, 2025 and Republic Day programme on 26th January, 2025:

PART A - STATEHOOD DAY PROGRAMME

1. ICA Department will chalk out a separate programme for observance of Statehood Day on 21st January, 2025 and place before the authority or approval. They will also publish a folder on the eve of Statehood Day programme-2025 containing achievement of the Government and distribute the same to all concerned accordingly.

(Action by: ICA Department)

2. ILLUMINATION

Like previous years, all the important Government Offices/Establishments like Raj Bhavan, Tripura Legislative Assembly, Secretariat, Tripura High Court building etc. will be illuminated by the concerned authorities with the active support from the Power Department and PWD (Internal Electrification) prior to the commencement of the Statehood Day programme i.e. 20th January, 2025 and may continue up to 26th January, 2025.

(Action by: All concerned Departments/ Power Department/ PWD(Internal Electrification / DM, West)

3. CITY CLEANING

Like previous years, a cleaning programme (Swachchata Abhijan) will be carried out and completed by 20th January. 2025 by the Municipal Commissioner, AMC to keep clean Agartala City, all Government Offices, Educational Institutions and other establishments. In this regard, respective Offices/Institutions will take action to clean their Offices/Institutions and AMC will arrange for removal of wastes from those office premises. Municipal Commissioner, AMC will also take special care to keep neat and clean in and around the areas of Assam Rifles Ground, Murtiprangan (near

Circuit House), Gandhi Bedi (at Gandhighat) and Martyr's Memorial (at Albert Ekka Park, Lichubagan). Old, dirty and undesirable posters etc. near the road side of Agartala City may be removed by AMC. Besides, adequate number of new plaques / banners may be put up within the town area during the occasion for giving a festive look. The Municipal Commissioner, AMC will also make arrangement for painting of roadside near Assam Rifles Ground, Old Raj Bhavan, Gandhighat, Martyrs' Memorial at Albert Ekka Park and wall of Heritage Park. Horticulture Department will make arrangement to ornate the Murtiprangan near Circuit House well in advance.

PART B-REPUBLIC DAY PROGRAMME

1. VENUE

1.1 It has been decided that State level Republic Day programme on 26.01.2025 will be held at Assam Rifles Ground. The GA(Political) Department will take up with the Director General, Assam Rifles, Shillong to obtain formal permission to use Assam Rifles Ground from 5th January, 2025 onwards as were done in earlier occasions.

(Action by: Secretary, GA(Political)/DIG, Assam Rifles/DM(W)

1.2 Like previous occasions, DGP will make necessary arrangements for securing the Assam Rifles ground in advance of the function and till conclusion of the ceremony. Similar arrangements will also be taken by the DGP for other Districts/Sub-Divisions/ Blocks. The G.A.(Political) Department has already requested all the DMs to send the draft programme along with list of grounds of the District Headquarters, Sub-Divisional and Block Headquarters where the ceremonial unfurling of the National Flag will be held on 26.01.2025. On receipt of the Ground list, G.A.(Political) Department will send the same to the DGP for securing and sterilizing of those grounds.

(Action by: DGP/GA(Political) Department/all DMs)

2. PROGRAMME OF THE HON'BLE GOVERNOR OF TRIPURA.

2.1 The GA(Political)Department will take up with the Secretary to the Governor, Tripura to obtain kind consent of the Hon'ble Governor to grace the programme for unfurling of the National Flag and taking of salute at Assam Rifles Ground on 26.01.2025 at 0900 hrs.

(Action by: GA(Political) Department / Secretary to the Governor)

2.2 Arrangements for AT HOME function at Raj Bhavan on 26.01.2025 at 1600 hrs will be made by the Governor's Secretariat with the assistance of DM (West) and ICA Department. All concerned may render necessary assistance for it.

(Action by: Secretary to the Governor/DM, West/ICA Department)

2.3 DM (West) will make arrangements in consultation with the Secretary to the Governor of Tripura for putting up of Shamianas etc. at the Raj Bhavan Lawn to organize High Tea and Cultural Programme if any. He may also take special care for distribution of invitation cards of At Home programme as were done in previous years. ICA Department will take necessary action for the Cultural Programme in consultation with the Raj Bhavan.

(Action by: Secretary to the Governor/DM, West/ ICA Department)

2.4 DGP will arrange Police Band for AT HOME function. Proper care may be taken by the ADC to the Governor so that playing of National Anthem and Band Party are played in synchronized manner.

(Action by: ADC to the Governor/ DGP/ICA Department)

2.5 DM(West) in consultation with Secretary to the Governor will make arrangement for proper refreshment. Warm burners etc. may be kept for warming of food items.

(Action by: Secretary to the Governor/DM(W))

3 PARTICIPATION OF CENTRAL ARMED POLICE FORCES

DGP may identify the number of contingents including CRPF, BSF, Assam Rifles, State Police, TSR, Home Guards, Civil Defence, Forest Guards, NCC, NSS, Scouts & Guides etc. who will participate in the parade/march past during the state level function on 26.01.2025. The DGP may hold a meeting with the CAPF for their participation in parade/march past. Good quality of parade may be organized. DGP will also ensure for Police Band.

(Action by: DGP/PCCF/ Secretary, Home/DM(West/ Secretary, YA & S)

4. STATE LEVEL PROGRAMME AND MINUTE -TO-MINUTE PROGRAMME

January, 2025 and send it to the GA(Political) Department well in time for obtaining Government approval. He will also prepare Minute-to-Minute programme of Assam Rifles ground including Parade and Cultural programme etc. and send the same to the GA(Political) Department for obtaining Government approval. DM & Collector, West Tripura will also make arrangements for distribution of invitation cards of the State Level programme to all invitees well in time and make erection of pandal

and proper seating arrangements with the help of PWD (R&B) and receiving the invitees in appropriate manner.

(Action by: G.A.(Political) Department / DM(West) / Chief Engineer, PWD (R&B))

4.2 Power, ICA and PWD Departments will render all necessary assistance towards preparation for the State Level functions. Power Department will also provide uninterrupted power supply on the day of occasion at Assam Rifles ground, Raj Bhavan and other respective venues.

(Action by: Power Department / ICA Department/ Chief Engineer, PWD (R & B)

5. PARTICIPATION OF PUBLIC

DGP will issue the traffic plan 2(two) days prior to the programme for convenience of public to attend the Republic Day parade at Assam Rifles Ground. ICA Department will also take steps for wide publicity through print & electronic media prior to the occasion as were done in earlier. DM (West) will also make proper seating arrangements for the general public and guardians of the participating children at Assam Rifles ground on the day of occasion as were done in previous years.

(Action by: DGP/DM(W)/ICA Department)

6. ISSUE OF GENERAL INSTRUCTION FOR THE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

Like previous occasions, the GA(AR) Department will issue a general instruction for the officers and staff of all Departments to attend the programme of ceremonial unfurling of the National Flag at their respective offices as well as the State level programme at Assam Rifles Ground. All Heads of Department shall ensure participation of officers/staff in the State level function at Assam Rifles Ground on 26.01.2025 at 0900 hrs.

(Action by: GA(AR) Department/All Heads of Department)

7. COMMENTATOR/ANNOUNCER

ICA Department will arrange PA system at all ceremonial places. ICA Department will also perform announcement of the entire State level programme at Assam Rifles Ground. The DGP will provide necessary assistance to the ICA Department for preparation of consolidated Announcement Script of Parade/March Past and the Secretary, Education/Secretary, YAS Department will provide necessary assistance to the ICA Department for preparation of consolidated Announcement Script for the cultural programme. Secretary, ICA shall remain overall in-charge for preparation of the draft consolidated script and send it to GA(Political) Department to obtain Government approval well in time.

(Action by: DGP/Secretary, YAS/Secretary, ICA/GA(Political) Department/Special Secretary, Education Department)

8. CULTURAL PROGRAMME

8.1 The following Cultural Committee has been constituted to finalize the Cultural programme of Republic Day, 2025: -

8.2 The Cultural Committee will finalize 30 (thirty) minutes duration quality cultural programme by Education (Secondary) Department, YA & S Department and TTAADC (including Patriotic song, Dance and P.T) and send proposal to the GA(Political) Department by 3rd January, 2025 for Government approval. The Cultural Committee will also look into the matter that any additional programme may not to be performed at AR Ground without prior approval of the Government and the duration of cultural programme strictly restricted within 30 minutes so that the programme does not become monotonous.

8.3 The Chief Executive Officer, TTAADC will make arrangements for participation of one cultural team from TTAADC at Assam Rifles Ground to perform one cultural item. He may also ensure the participation of Cultural Team in rehearsals as decided by the Cultural Committee.

8.4 The Secretary, Tribal Welfare Department will take necessary action to organize traditional Tribal Folk Dance at Rabindra Shatabarshiki Bhavan and Dinner with Tribal Leaders at M.T.B.Girls H.S. School on 26.01.2025 in befitting manner as were done in previous years.

(Action by: Secretary, Tribal Welfare Department / DM(West)).

9. PRESENTATION OF TABLEAUX

This time there will be no tableau item on 26.01.2025 at Assam Rifles Ground. However, ICA Department may arrange live screening of State tableaux in Delhi.

10. COVERAGE OF THE STATE LEVEL PROGRAMME AT ASSAM RIFLES GROUND BY DOORDARSHAN KENDRA / ALL INDIA RADIO. AGARTALA

The ICA Department will take up the matter with the Station Director, Doordarshan Kendra and Station Director, All India Radio, Agartala and other electronic media for coverage of the entire programme at Assam Rifles Ground on 26.01.2025.

(Action by: ICA Department/Station Director, Doordarshan/Station Director, All India Radio)

11. GROUND REHEARSAL FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

DGP will take decision regarding ground rehearsal with Police and CAPF. The Cultural Committee will take decision regarding ground rehearsal for school students. Ground rehearsal for school students may be held at least 10 days out of which 3 days may be at Assam Rifles Ground on any suitable days of January, 2025 in synchronization with the parade/march past.

12. FULL DRESS REHEARSAL OF PARADE

Full Dress rehearsal of the parade will be held at Assam Rifles Ground on 24th January, 2025 including all contingents and participating school students.

(Action by: DGP/CEO,TTAADC/Director, Secondary Education/Director, YAS)

13. DURATION OF TOTAL PROGRAMME

Ceremonial functions, including parade, awarding of various awards, etc. to be restricted within 45 minutes and all cultural functions by School Education Department, YA & Sports Department and TTAADC to be restricted within 30 minutes and the duration of the total programme to be restricted within 110-120 minutes on 26.1.2025 at Assam Rifles Ground.

(Action by: All concerned)

14. CAR PARKING

Like previous occasions, SP (Traffic) will make necessary arrangements of car parking of the VVIPs and VIPs at the function of Assam Rifles Ground, At Home programme at Raj Bhavan and other venues. He will also make arrangement to control movement of vehicles on road on that day. DM(West) will arrange fixing numbers on the vehicles of VVIPs/VIPs. This will help the traffic police to marshal the carcade properly. DM(West) may send the list of Invitees/Guests to the SP(Traffic) well in advance.

(Action by: SP(Traffic)/DM(West)/all concerned)

15. MOVEMENT OF MEDIA PERSONS AND PHOTOGRAPHERS IN DIFFERENT FUNCTIONS

15.1 For smooth movement of the media persons and photographers, Director, ICA and police authority may hold a joint meeting with the representatives of the Press and Working Journalists Associations and their suggestion/views/cooperation may be sought. SP (SB)/ SP (Security) and Director, ICA will ensure checking of equipment of media persons/reporters on the day of ceremony.

(Action by: SP (Security)/DM (West)/ Director, ICA/SP (SB)/SP(West))

15.2 An area will be earmarked by DM(West) for movement of the photographers. They should not be allowed to move freely in the ground and they may be suitably briefed in advance by ICA Department and Police authority.

(Action by: DM (W)/Director,ICA/SP (West))

15.3 ICA Department will take steps to digitize the programme. An archive may be built up to preserve the documents of all State level functions and to share it with all concerned Departments for future improvement and use. Education (Higher) Department will properly preserve the archives on receipt of CD from the ICA Department.

(Action by: Director, ICA/Director Higher Education/ All concerned Departments)

16. MISCELLANEOUS

16.1 Like previous occasions, Netaji's Birthday (including procession) will be observed on 23rd January, 2025 at Netaji Subhash Vidyaniketan, Agartala with full conformity.

(Action by: Director, Secondary Education/DM(West)/SP(West)/SP(Traffic))

16.2 The Secretary, ICA Department will take necessary action in consultation with the Secretary to the Hon'ble Governor and Secretary to the hon'ble Chief Minister for telecast/broadcast of the recorded message of the Hon'ble Governor and the hon'ble Chief Minister for the people of Tripura on the eve of Republic Day, 2025. The Planning & Coordination Department will collect and compile the materials and send it to the Governor's Secretariat and Chief Minister's Secretariat well in time. Subsequently, the Governor's Secretariat and the Chief Minister's Secretariat will prepare the Message of Hon'ble Governor and Hon'ble Chief Minister respectively.

(Action by: Secretary to the Governor/Secretary to CM/Secretary, Planning & Coordination/Secretary, ICA)

16.3 The D.M. & Collector, West Tripura will arrange sufficient number of dustbin, drinking water and tiffin at the Assam Rifles Ground on 26.01.2025 for the school children. He will also earmark suitable space for the school children at the eastern side of the Assam Rifles Ground. AMC will assist to clean the field after the programme.

(Action by: DM(West)/ Municipal Commissioner, AMC)

16.4 The decoration of the parade ground and markings thereon will be arranged by the DGP. DM(West) will make arrangement for Shamianas and colour umbrellas. Government Art College & Purbasha will provide colour clothes and handicraft items for decoration of parade ground. The students and the Principal of the Government College of Arts and Crafts may also be associated with such arrangements.

(Action by: DGP/DM(West)/Director, Higher Education/Director, HH & S)

16.5 Horticulture Department will provide sufficient flowers, bouquets etc. for Assam Rifles Ground, wreath and flower for Gandhighat and Martyr's Memorial, At Home function etc. as per requisition of the District Magistrate & Collector, West Tripura.

(Action by: DM (West)/ Director, Horticulture)

16.6 Director, Health Services will depute a Medical Team at Assam Rifles Ground during the period of rehearsals. He may also provide Medical Team with Ambulance on the day of ceremony on 26.01.2025 at Assam Rifles Ground. DM(West) will earmark space for stationing the Medical Team and Ambulance.

(Action by: Director, Health Services/ DM (West))

16.7 The Secretary, GA(SA) Department will take necessary action for hoisting of National Flag at the Secretariat Building on 26.01.2025. at 0730 hrs. He will issue instruction for all Officers and Staff of the Secretariat to remain present in the Flag Hoisting programme at the Secretariat.

(Action by: Secretary, GA(SA) Department)

16.8 The Director, Fire Service will make arrangement for adequate fire extinguishers at Assam Rifles ground, Raj Bhavan and other venues.

(Action by: Director, Fire Service)

16.9 The Director, Directorate of Sainik Welfare will make arrangement for the programme at the Martyrs' Memorial, Albert Ekka Park on 26.01.2025 at 0700 hrs. He will also take necessary action for organizing of Ex-Servicemen Sammelan on 26.01.2025 at the State Capital and District Headquarters.

(Action by: Director, Directorate of Sainik Welfare / DM(West/All other DMs))

16.10 Like previous years, People of 3rd Gender community may be invited to attend the programme of State Level Republic Day on 26.01.2025 at Assam Rifles ground.

16.11 Assam Rifles authority will make arrangements to maintain the road around the Assam Rifles ground for entrance of the VVIPs/VIPs.

(Action by: DIG, Assam Rifles)

16.12 DM & Collector, West Tripura will take suitable steps to repair and restore the Assam Rifles Ground after the conclusion of the programme with the assistance of PWD (R & B).

(Action by: DM(West)/PWD (R & B))

16.13 The Horticulture Society, Tripura will organize Horticulture Show at Rabindra Kanan from 23rd to 25th January, 2025 and arrange distribution of prizes on 26th January, 2025. They will also organize sit & draw and alpana competition on 24th January, 2025 and a cultural programme on 25th January, 2025 in the evening as was done in previous years.

(Action by: Horticulture Society, Tripura/ Director, Horticulture & SC)

16.14 Like previous years, the Youth Affairs & Sports Department and Tripura Sports Council will organize a friendly cricket match for the blind at MBB stadium and an exhibition football match for women at Swami Vivekananda Maidan on 24th January, 2025 as were done earlier. They will also organize a Cross-Country Race on 25th January, 2025 from Umakanta Academy premises.
